POSITION DESCRIPTION									

Unit Animal Experts are Rated and Non-Rated members of the Central Aid Agency who are recognized as animal experts within their unit. Unit Animal Experts receive advanced training and serve as go-to subject matter experts in operations related to, or concerning, animals. Unit Animal Experts are cross trained, and carry out the normal duties related to their unit in addition to being an animal expert. In general, Unit Animal Experts serve in Emergency Response focused units and provide guidance related to animals during incident response.

TYPE OF ASSIGNMENT

This is an Additional Duty Assignment. Personnel assigned to this role carry out the related duties in addition to their main role within the Central Aid Agency, and must maintain simultaneous standards for both roles. Unit Animal Experts fall under the regulatory policies of Animal Operations and the Animal Rescue Unit, but may belong to any Command.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES

- Provide direction and guidance when working with animals.
- Assist with animal emergency evacuations as needed.
- Provide guidance and insight when establishing animal-related strategies.
- Assist with establishing and operating emergency animal shelters, as needed.
- Assist with animal care, as needed.
- Assist partner agencies with animal operations or support, as needed.
- Participate in regular training, continuing education, and related activities.
- Other related duties as assigned.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT

This position is open to both Rated and Non-Rated personnel.

FAITH REQUIREMENT

- No specific faith requirement.
- Personnel must follow the Code of Conduct.

HOURS / ACTIVENESS REQUIREMENTS

 Personnel must maintain the minimum activeness standards required by their level of Rating or membership type.

PAYSCALE

• This is a volunteer position

BENEFITS

• No benefits are currently offered for this position

HYGIENE AND APPEARANCE REQUIREMENTS

• Recognized Unit Animal Experts follow the hygiene and appearance requirements of their home unit.

UNIFORM

- Unit Animal Experts wear the uniform of their home unit.
- Unit Animal Experts may be identified by specialized insignia worn on their uniform.

EQUIPMENT

- Equipment personally purchased by personnel is their property and they may keep it upon leaving the agency.
- All other equipment is issued to personnel and must be returned upon leaving the agency.

DESCRIPTION OF SELECTION PROCESS

- Application Submission
- Approval by an Officer within the chain of command.
- Assignment and designation as an Animal Expert within the unit.
- Complete any required training.
- Receive insignia and/or role patch to be displayed on the uniform.
- Personnel will be on probation for up to six (6) months after initial assignment.

ELIGIBILITY

- This role is open to Rated and Non-Rated personnel.
- The Unit Animal Expert role is open to all, no prior experience required.

CERTIFICATIONS:

- Must complete any required training for this role.
- Must complete any required training for the parent assigned unit.
- Must complete ICS 100, 200, and 700 within 3 months of assuming role (if not already certified).
- Ham radio certification (Technician or above) is strongly recommended.
 Personnel who are or become ham radio certified will be issued a radio and given preference for promotion and special assignments.

ABILITY/BACKGROUND:

- Must be comfortable in the presence of death and/or corpses.
- Must be comfortable facing and overcoming difficult physical challenges.
- Must be comfortable operating in this role.

- Must be willing to meet the scheduling and training requirements of the role.
- Must be comfortable around blood, first aid and/or medical emergencies.
